There are two basic types of transactions that will be covered, depending on whether property is or is not transferred.

This 2-hour session will help the tax practitioner understand:

- The tax consequences of property not relinquished when a loan is modified or balance adjusted;
- The tax consequences of property relinquished to the lender;
- How to deal with Cancellation of Debt income;
- The exclusions under Sec. 108.

David M. Fogel, CPA, is a tax consultant who supports other tax practitioners and represents clients before the various tax authorities. He has over 40 years of experience in tax controversy and tax planning matters, including 26 years with the IRS (as a Tax Auditor and Revenue Agent and 18 years as an Appeal Officer) and six years as a tax advisor for two law firms. Mr. Fogel has written over 65 articles published in California Tax Lawyer, Tax Notes, California CPA, California Enrolled Agent, EA Journal, and other publications.
